

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. Age limit for JRF is 28 years as on 01.12.2023 but age relaxation will be considered as per Government of Tamil Nadu norms for reserved category candidates.
- 2. The candidates called for the Written Examination and Personal Interview should report at Advanced Institute for Wildlife Conservation (Near Vandalur Zoo), Vandalur, Chennai-600048, with original documents on the designated date and time. If the number of applicants is too high, shortlisted of candidates will be done and only the short listed candidates will be called for the stages of written exam and Personal Interview
- 3. Application should be in the prescribed format, duly signed and should be accompanied by self-attested copies of documents on educational qualifications, research experience, UGC/CSIR/GATE certificate (if any), extracurricular activities, date of birth, mark sheets of all examinations, community certificate (if seeking relaxation as per Government of Tamil Nadu rules), etc.
- 4. The Institute will not provide accommodation and no TA/DA will be paid to the candidates appearing for the written examination and subsequent personal interview.
- 5. At the time of the verification of original documents or even after selection, if it is found that an attempt has been made by the applicant to wilfully conceal, misrepresent the facts or canvass, such application will be rejected, and due action will be taken against the candidate.

- 7. The date and time of the personal interview will be intimated individually by email to the shortlisted candidates.
- 8. If candidates score equal marks, the senior person in terms of the Date of Birth shall be given priority
